<b>18.21</b>	<b>APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE</b> Apologies for absence received: Cllr Frank Beech (no reason given) <b>Absent:</b> None
<b>19.21</b>	<b>DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS AND ANY OTHER INTERESTS IN AGENDA ITEMS</b> a) Declaration of any disclosable pecuniary interest in a matter to be discussed at the meeting and which is not included in the register of interests. <b>None received.</b> b) To consider any applications for dispensation. <b>None received.</b> c) Declaration of any other interests in agenda items. <b>None received.</b>
<b>20.21</b>	<b>CO-OPTION ONTO THE COUNCIL</b> It was <b>NOTED</b> that one application for co-option had been received. The application was considered and it was <b>RESOLVED</b> to co-opt Cara Holding onto the council. Cllr Holding then signed a Declaration of Acceptance of Office and reported that she had no interests to declare in accordance with item 19.21.
<b>21.21</b>	<b>MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 20 MAY 2021</b> It was <b>RESOLVED</b> to confirm the above minutes as a true record and the Chairman was instructed to sign the minutes as such.
<b>22.21</b>	<b>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION – <i>The Chairman advised that issues raised in this session may be recorded in public minutes and the member of the public consented to this.</i></b> The Member of the Public advised that he was attending in order to hear the outcome of a meeting between ABP/Shropshire Council/ABP Liaison Group.
<b>23.21</b>	<b>REPORTS RECEIVED AND NOTED:</b> a) <b>ABP</b> – The two representatives responded to concerns about HGVs using the incorrect route, speeding vehicles and littering and explained what steps ABP are taking to deal with these issues. They also explained that the landscaping had been removed from the south entrance to make space for cars to park due to the decreased use of car sharing during the pandemic. b) <b>Shropshire Council elected councillor</b> – Written report <b>NOTED</b> . Cllr Bardsley also reported on two ABP Liaison Group meetings and a site meeting held in June 2021. It was noted at the meetings that there was a concerning disregard for the speed limit coming into Lower Hordley from both the Ellesmere direction and more so from the Queens Head direction. Cllr Bardsley outlined four possible mitigation measures being considered, the funding of which would require ABP to agree to extend the expired time limit on monies currently held by Shropshire Council which are now returnable to
