18.26 ELECTION OF VICE CHAIRMAN

It was proposed and seconded that Cllr Tumelty be elected as Vice Chairman and he was then duly ELECTED by a majority vote and signed an Acceptance of Office Form.

19.26 MINUTES OF MAY ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

Cllr Bardsley confirmed the accuracy of the May minutes but it was NOTED that as he was the only member present who had attended the May annual meeting of the Parish Council, a majority vote to confirm the minutes was not possible. It was therefore RESOLVED to defer approval of the minutes until the September Parish Council meeting.

20.26 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION

A member of the public reported that he has a collection of old maps that he could make available should the Council need any historical information, as well as some old Parish Council records (not minutes) from when he was Chairman of the Parish Council. He also reported that Hordley Church is struggling for funds to maintain the churchyard opposite the church and would welcome any suggestions for fundraising.

- b) **Shropshire Council elected councillor** – a written report from Cllr Robert Jones was NOTED, including Queens Head/Rednall Mill resurfacing; Local Transport Plan

consultation; Commissioning, procurement and contract management; Shropshire Council's next steps towards sustainability; Shropshire Council corporate peer challenge update. Cllr Bardsley advised that he would be attending a meeting about the Local Transport Plan for Baschurch Parish Council and would report back to Hordley Parish Council as well.

- b) NOTED that no applications have been received for co-option onto the Council. Recruitment of a new councillor was considered and it was agreed that an advert should be placed on the noticeboards, and members should take opportunities to invite contacts in the community to apply for co-option.
